INCLUDE PARTICIPANT'S NAME ON PAYMENT ON CHECK

INITIAL \$ 100.00 DEPOSIT FOR YOUTH AND ADULTS BECOMES NON-REFUNDABLE AFTER SELECTION TO EXPEDITION. Refunds of deposit are only made under the following circumstances:

- If space not available to remove from waiting lists as of June 1, 2009.
- Under unusual circumstances with Lodge Professional Adviser Approval.

Since spaces are limited and waiting lists often develop no refunds of deposit will be made to participants who "decide not to go" "not longer interested", something else came up etc.

ANY REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS OF OTHER PAYMENTS IN ADDITION TO INITIAL DEPOSIT WILL BE HANDLED BY THE CONTINGENT LEADERSHIP AND LODGE ADVISERS. ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE ADULT CONTINGENT LEADER OR THE LODGE ADVISER. APPEALS CAN BE MADE THROUGH THE LODGE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

This is due to Council Expeditions having to make scheduled non-refundable non-transferable payments to National BSA, and transportation providers. In general, if an alternate IS NOT FOUND to replace the original participant refunds will be limited to the amount that is refunded to the expedition and Old North State Council.

IN UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES sickness or injury to participant or serious family situation refunds are also possible if participant has to drop out of expedition at a late date. In these cases the High Adventure Committee may be requested to review the situation and make the highest possible refund to the participant's family.

VI. OLD NORTH STATE COUNCIL AND THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

Expedition Dates: Friday July 31, 2009 – Thursday August 6, 2009

Travel plans include leaving Greensboro on Friday July 31, 2009. Contingent will stop overnight on way to Indiana University and stay in a hotel. Travel to Indiana University and arrive at NOAC on Saturday August 1, 2009. Leave Indiana University and return to Greensboro on Thursday August 6, 2009.

Each person attending NOAC must be a registered delegate of a Lodge. Tsoiotsi Tsogalii Lodge will only accept delegates who agree to the terms and conditions of this application, and agree to full payment of delegate fees in the amount listed above. Except for unusual circumstances, Tsoiotsi Tsogalii Lodge will not accept delegates who want to drive separate from the Lodge delegation.

National Order of the Arrow Conference is based on a college campus, and each participant is housed in a campus dormitory. Participants are not allowed to have personal vehicles or golf carts to drive around the campus to attend training and other events. Campus bus transportation is normally provided; however, it the busses are usually crowded. Each participant will be expected to walk to and from the NOAC events.

Every Adult participant will be expected to take on a leadership responsibility with the NOAC contingent, and will be assigned one or more contingent responsibilities for this event.

PRIOR TO MAY 31, 2009, EVERY ADULT MUST ALSO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

- COMPLETE BASIC LEADER TRAINING APPROPRIATE TO YOUR PRIMARY REGISTERED POSITION IN SCOUTING. THIS MUST, HOWEVER, INCLUDE THE BOY SCOUT LEADER OUTDOOR SESSION.
- COMPLETE YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING UPDATE.
