## TSDIOTSI TSOGALII LODGE

**COME:** Learn how to make Native American regalia! Learn more about ceremonies.

**WHEN AND WHERE:** the following Saturdays from 9 am to noon:

- February 13, 2010 at Old North State Scout Office: Ribbon Shirt/War Shirt, Feathers for head dresses.
- March 13, 2010 at Old North State Scout Office: Cut out Ribbon Shirt, finish head dresses, and beading: appliqué, loom, and lazy stitch.
- March 27, 2010 at Camp Cherokee (Spring Fellowship): Leggings and Aprons, Cut-out War Shirt, Beading.

**WHO:** OA Youth and Adults, Boy Scouts, Adults, Moms, Dads (OA membership NOT required!)—anyone who is interested in learning more about Native American culture.

**WHAT:** Learn to make your own regalia and also, the Lodge needs people to help refurbish or create Native American style clothing. The Lodge needs ceremony teams.

**WHY:** More participation is needed by both youth and adults in IA activities. We need a community to support our youth in their activities—

- We need more ceremony teams (and coaches).
- Adults are encouraged to participate in Singing and Dance activities at powwows to provide continuity of the program and good examples of how to dance and sing at the drum for Youth. More participation is desired in powwows and other IA activities for adults and youth.
- Our current regalia are wearing out and needs replacing.
- A group of people need to know how to make and care for regalia—one or two people cannot do it all.
- The volume of events is increasing that requires the use of regalia and more regalia are needed—Webelos cross-over ceremonies, Induction and Brotherhood ceremonies, group dance.
- It's more fun doing things together!

**HOW:** We will start at the beginning and learn what things should look like, what materials to choose, how to make an item, and have the opportunity to complete an item by the end of the three sessions. Ceremony teams will have the chance to learn and practice ceremonies.
