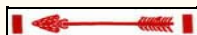


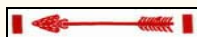

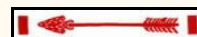

Brotherhood Conferences at Chapter Meetings

The lodge has called upon Tutelo Chapter's help to meet a critical goal. This goal is converting 30% of the Ordeal members to Brotherhood members before the end of 2009.

This is a critical goal that the lodge needs to meet. If this goal is not met, the lodge will not earn the Quality Lodge Award.

How can Tutelo Chapter help? The Brotherhood Conference (formally known as Brotherhood Testing) can be done at the chapter level. Once the conference is complete, all the person has to do is participate in the Brotherhood Ceremony which is typically done at most all lodge functions.

The conference involves several things. These include:

1. Be active as an Ordeal Member for ten months and make sure that your Lodge Dues have been paid for next year. They only cost \$10.00 per year.
2. Learn the Obligation (This can be found in your Order of the Arrow Handbook).
3. Learn the words to the Official Order of the Arrow Song (Also found in your Order of the Arrow Handbook).

4. Be able to demonstrate the handclasp, repeat the Obligation, state what the Admonition is and what it means, the symbol of our Order, and what WWW means.

In addition, you must fill out a form in which you explain 1.) what you think the Obligation means, 2.) describe how you have been fulfilling the Obligation in your Troop and in your daily life, 3.) how you have used your understanding of ordeal to aid in this service and 4.) describe your specific plans for giving service in the Lodge program.

At the Tutelo Chapter meeting on October 15, 2009, the chapter will be conducting Brotherhood Conferences with any Ordeal members who are ready to convert to Brotherhood. Those who do this will be able to go through the Brotherhood Ceremony at the Fall Fellowship in November.
